PART I – Program Enrollment:

I, (Parent's First Name, Last Name), hereby give my child, the student, permission to enroll and participate in Denver Public Schools' CareerResidency Youth Apprenticeship Program (CRYA Program) for the 2018-2019 School Year.

I have had the opportunity to learn about the CRYA Program from [name of the School representative] and understand that the program combines traditional high school classroom learning with on-the-job experiences and higher education.

I understand that if my child participates, that part of the experience requires my student to leave school grounds and travel to participating companies' work site and to college campuses from time to time.

I understand that Denver Public Schools and the CRYA Program will not provide any transportation and my child will be required to either use public transportation or will rely on the use of his/her own means of transportation.

I understand that if my child enrolls in the CareerResidency Youth Apprenticeship Program that successful participation requires a three (3) year commitment and during that time, in the process of earning a high school diploma he/she may have the opportunity to earn industry credentials, college credit, and work experiences.

PART II – Student Data Privacy Information:

During the course of this program, your student will engage in a variety of activities that require the sharing of your student's personally identifiable information (SPII) with third-party service providers. Circumstances where your student's data may be shared may include but are not limited to:

- Workplace/employer placement through the CareerWise Colorado (CWC) Marketplace and/or sharing resume and required employment information directly with employers
The creation of online social media profiles such as LinkedIn
Tracking of attainment of industry-related competencies through Motivis, a learning management system
Assessing strengths through the Pairin Readiness Management System
CareerResidency Youth Apprenticeship Program implementation studies conducted to evaluate program effectiveness

CWC has signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with DPS that ensures their program will adhere and comply with all relevant federal, state, local, and district requirements to include the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), and Colorado's Student Data Transparency and Security Act. However, due to the dynamic nature of the CareerResidency program as well as each student's unique qualifications regarding career interest and employment opportunities, Denver Public Schools has a limited ability to track all of the different ways that this data may be shared.

PART III – Permission and Release for Print, Electronic and District Media

Because of the community's interest in public education, print and electronic media sometimes request to visit schools for stories about programs and current events. Permission for close - up photographs and interviews of students under the age of 18 years old can be granted to the media only with parent approval.
